1.0 INTRODUCTION

Coal India Limited is a Schedule – A, Navratna Company, with a commitment towards becoming a responsible and socially conscious organization in the country.

2.0 OBJECTIVE OF THE SCHEME

Spread quality professional education among the economically weaker sections of society. Support deserving, meritorious Below Poverty Line students with means to nurture successful careers.

3.0 NUMBER OF SCHOLARSHIPS

A total of 100 scholarships (94 scholarships for Engineering discipline – Electrical, Mechanical, Civil and Mining and 06 scholarships for Medical disciplines) shall be awarded on merit-cum-means basis every year commencing from the academic year 2010 – 2011 based on the eligibility criteria mentioned below.

4.0 ELIGIBILITY

4.1 Course, Discipline & Institute - The Coal India Scholarship shall be awarded to students pursuing full-time degree course (Graduation) in Engineering (Btech/BE) in selected IITs, NITs and in State Government Engineering colleges where CIL is conducting recruitment through campus selection and full-time degree course (Graduation) in Medicine (MBBS) in Selected Government Medical college in India (list of colleges enclosed). Students having confirmed admission only in the first year of full time engineering / medicine degree course are eligible to apply

4.2 Family Income – Candidates having the Below Poverty Line (BPL) Card issued only by the competent authority under Govt. of India and State Govt. are eligible to apply for the Coal India Scholarship for BPL students.

4.3 Merit Criteria – For the merit criteria the following will be considered - rank secured and percentage of marks obtained in the qualifying entrance examination for the courses



(i.e. IIT / AIEEE / State Govt. Entrance Examinations for Engineering and Medical Entrance for Govt. Medical colleges).

4.4 Age Limit - Maximum 25 years as on the first November of the current academic session.

4.5 Others – The candidate should not be in any kind of employment, should not be in receipt of any other scholarship from any other source and should not have any criminal record. Students in receipt of Coal India scholarship will not be entitled to draw any other scholarship / Financial Aid / Stipend from any other source.

5.0 VALUE, DURATION AND DISBURSEMENT OF SCHOLARSHIP

5.1 Amount and Duration - The scholarship covers reimbursement of Tuition fees, Hostel fees and Incidental fees upto Rs. 10,000 /- per academic session. The Scholarship is admissible from the first year till the final year of the course subject to the condition that **the student clears all semesters / years in single attempt and secures the requisite percentage in each semester / yearly examination to the satisfaction of Coal India.**

5.2 Manner of Disbursement - The amount shall be paid every yr w.e.f. the year of admission. If the course is in semester system, the yearly amount shall be paid in installments according to the number of semesters in each yr of the course. Cheques (A/c Payee) would be released to the college authority/ mess authority to ensure regular payment against the students selected for Coal India Scholarship.

5.3 Review & Renewal – The Scholarship shall be reviewed and renewed every yr till the completion of the course. The continuation of the scholarship shall depend on the progress / performance of the student in each class or semester and subsequent promotion to next class / semester provided he/she secures 50% or more marks in aggregate in the semester / annual examination which determines his/her promotion to the next class or semester. **A scholar dropped in a semester / class shall be disqualified.**

5.4 Manner of Renewal - For renewal of scholarship, the student will have to send a request letter through their respective Head of the Institutions/Colleges within 15 days after the announcement of the result giving details of his/her academic performance in the last semester / academic yr and a letter of recommendation from the head of the institute.



6.0 APPLICATION

6.1 Candidates studying in the 1st yr of engineering or medicine degree course in the current yr, and satisfying all the eligibility conditions may submit their applications in the prescribed format duly completed in all respect along with supporting documents through the Head of the Institution/Colleges. While forwarding the application, the institute shall certify to the effect that information furnished by the candidate is correct and the institute is recognized by the Govt. of India or any other State Govt. respectively. The details of the scholarship scheme and format of application may be downloaded from the company website www.coalindia.in. The applications duly completed in the prescribed format along with the required enclosures (as mentioned in the application form) should be submitted to the concerned Head of the respective institutions/Colleges, who in turn will scrutinize the applications as per CIL Scholarship scheme and send the same with a Forwarding letter duly scrutinized and endorsement addressed to the Chief General Manager (Welfare), Coal India Limited, Coal Bhawan, 10, Netaji Subhas Road, Kolkata – 700001 so as to reach us by the last date as notified in the advertisement. **(All applications should be forwarded only through the Head of respective institutions/Colleges)**

6.2 A period of 60 (sixty) days from the date of taking admission in the respective Institution will be given to the students for submission of their application forms and relevant documents.

6.3 Applications not in the prescribed format or received after the closing date or not forwarded through the Head of the Institution are liable to be rejected.

7.0 PROCEDURE FOR AWARD OF SCHOLARSHIP

The award of scholarship and continuance thereof will be regulated as under:

7.1 Application - Students will be selected after they apply against a press advertisement or notification announcing the availability of Coal India Scholarships for Graduation course Engineering and Medicine (MBBS) studies.

7.2 Selection – Selection will be made on the basis of rank secured and percentage of marks obtained in the qualifying entrance examination for the courses (i.e. IIT / AIEEE / State Entrance Examinations for Engineering and Medical Entrance for Govt. Medical colleges). Final award will be strictly on Merit basis which will be scrutinized and recommended by a constituted selection Body / Forum of Coal India Ltd.



7.3 Endorsement by Institution – The applications must be duly recommended by the concerned Head of the Institution /College with a suitable endorsement as prescribed in the application form.

7.4 The decision of the company with respect to award of Scholarship and continuance and/or discontinuance as the case may be shall be final and binding.

7.5 Order of priority for award of Coal India Scholarship –

- a) 1st priority – students pursuing Engineering degree course in selected IITs

- d) 4th priority – students pursuing Engineering degree course (Graduation course) in State Govt. Engineering colleges where CIL is conducting recruitment through campus selection as per list

8.2 The students who are granted the Coal India Scholarship may also have the option for employment with Coal India after the successful completion of the course. **However, only award of the Scholarship will not guarantee any kind of employment with Coal India Limited, which will be the sole discretion of the management.**

1.0 INTRODUCTION

Coal India Limited is a Schedule – A, Navratna Company, with a commitment towards becoming a responsible and socially conscious organization in the country.

2.0 PREAMBLE

When Coal India or its subsidiaries, acquire land for existing /new mining projects, the land owners and the people who depend on that land for various reasons including residential and livelihood purposes are often displaced by the operations. These people are called Project Affected People (PAP).

A Rehabilitation and Resettlement Policy (R&R) has been developed aimed to elicit the cooperation of the PAP and acquire land for mining projects. This policy addresses the issues and concerns of all the stakeholders including the PAPs and the company quite comprehensively. However, as a socially responsible organization, Coal India has decided to offer a Scholarship to the wards of the PAPs for pursuing professional education in addition to the benefits given in the R&R Policy.

3.0 OBJECTIVE OF THE SCHEME

The objective of the Coal India Scholarship scheme for Project Affected People is to strengthen the future of the project affected communities by helping the spread of quality professional education among the meritorious and talented young generation who often get deprived of such opportunities due to non-availability of means to pursue such education.



4.0 NUMBER OF SCHOLARSHIPS

A total of 25 scholarships (23 scholarship for Engineering discipline – Electrical, Mechanical, Civil and Mining and rest 02 scholarships for Medical discipline) shall be awarded every year commencing from the academic yr 2010 – 2011 based on the eligibility criteria mentioned below.

5.0 ELIGIBILITY

5.1 Land Oustees / Displaced Person – The candidate must come under the definition of Project Affected People (PAP) or be a part of a Project Affected Family (PAF) according to the Rehabilitation and Resettlement Policy of Coal India Limited (can be viewed and downloaded from www.coalindia.in).
