2. BACKGROUND:

2.1. Under its diversification initiatives, Coal India Limited has identified Critical minerals as one of the potential area to venture into. The economic importance of critical minerals for value add industries, along with risks to stable supply make them strategically valuable. Coal India Limited is looking for the critical minerals like Ni, Co, Li and others in countries ranging from Australia, Argentina, Chile etc. Subsequently CIL has incorporated object clause pertaining to critical minerals business value chain in its Memorandum of Association to affirm its focus on critical mineral strategy as follows:
