

# THALASSEMIA BAL SEWA YOJNA

Coal India Limited under its Corporate Social Responsibility is running 'Thalassemia Bal Sewa Yojna', a scheme for curative treatment of Thalassemia and Aplastic Anaemia. Under this scheme, financial assistance upto Rs. 10 Lakh is provided for Bone Marrow Transplant in eight prominent hospitals spread across the country. Corpus fund has been provided to these hospitals for implementation of the scheme. The project is aimed at benefitting eligible patients who are unable to afford the high cost of the transplants.

## Eligibility:

Criteria	Thalassemia	Aplastic Anaemia
Age	Upto 12 years	Upto 18 years
Family income	Upto Rs 5 lakh per annum	Upto Rs 8 lakh per annum
Matching donor	Matched related donor	Matched related donor

## Clinical Requirements

### For Thalassemia:

- Patient should have transfusion dependent Thalassemia
- 100% HLA (Human Leukocyte Antigen) matched related donor
- Such patients must be other than Class III B patients, liver size of the patient to be less than 5cms below the coastal margin

### For Aplastic Anaemia:

- Patient should have severe Aplastic Anaemia as documented by a bone marrow examination
- Full 6/6 HLA matched related donor
- Necessary test for ruling out inherited bone marrow failure syndromes are to be done
