CIL 2nd interim dividend: Govt to get ₹2,037cr

COAL INDIA'S (CIL) second interim dividend will make the government richer by ₹2,037.8 crore, as it holds a 66.1% stake in the Maharatna PSU. The company on Monday announced a dividend of ₹5 per share of ₹10 each and the total payout will be ₹3,087 crore. In the first interim dividend, the miner's total payout was ₹5546 crore. India's coal output registered an increase of 6.13% to 79.60 million tonne in January.

Coal India Q3 net up 48% to ₹4,558 crore

New Delhi, 14 February

State-owned Coal India on Monday reported a 47.7 per cent rise in consolidated net profit to ₹4,558.39 crore for the quarter ended on December 31, 2021, on the back of higher revenue from operations.

The PSU's consolidated net profit was at ₹3,085.39 crore in the year-ago period, Coal India Ltd (CIL) said in a filing to BSE.

The consolidated revenue from operations of the company during October-December period increased to ₹28,433.50 crore from ₹23,686.03 crore in the year-ago period.

Consolidated expenses during the third quarter increased to ₹22,780.95 crore from ₹19,592.57 crore in the corresponding quarter of the previous fiscal.

The production of raw coal during the October-December period increased to 163.82 MT from 156.78 MT in the corresponding quarter of the previous fiscal.

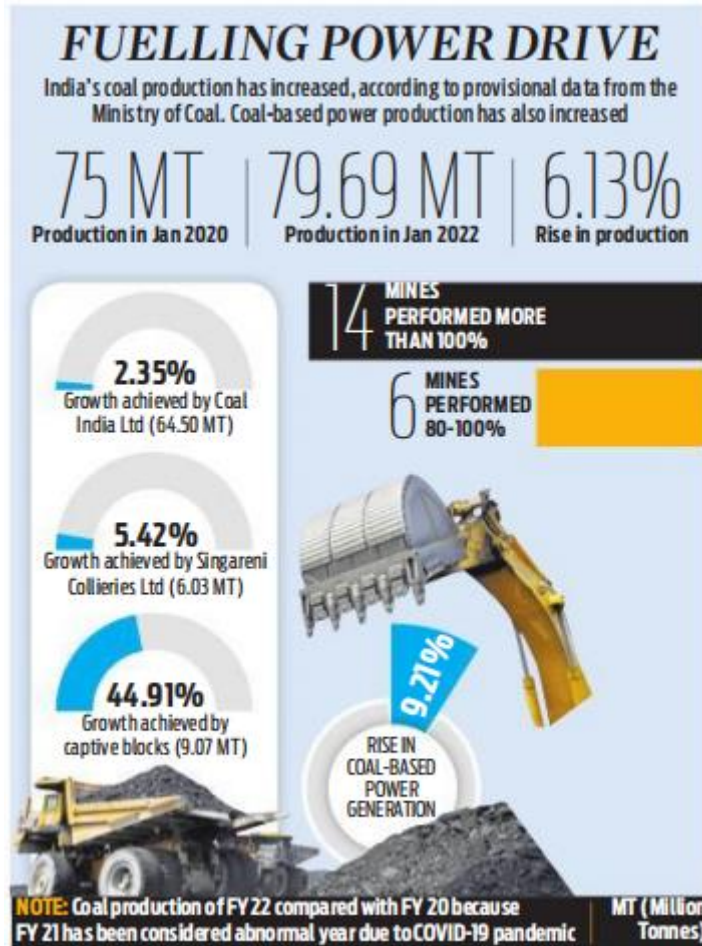
The offtake of raw coal also increased to 173.77 MT during the quarter from 154.46 MT in the year-ago period. It said that sales from e-auction in October-December period stood at ₹5,052.97 crore with an average realisation of ₹1,947.19 per tonne.

Coal India Ltd accounts for over 80 per cent of the total domestic coal output.

10,663 करोड़ मुनाफा हुआ कोल इंडिया को

जस, धनबाद : कोल इंडिया बोर्ड आफ डायरेक्टर की बैठक सोमवार को कोलकाता मुख्यालय में हुई। इस दौरान बताया गया कि तीसरी तिमाही में कोल इंडिया को 4556.54 करोड़ और तीनों तिमाही को मिलाकर 10663.42 करोड़ रुपये का मुनाफा हुआ है। बोर्ड मीटिंग में जारी रिजल्ट के मुताबिक कोल इंडिया ने तीसरी तिमाही में 163.82 मिलियन टन कच्चे कोयले का उत्पादन किया है, जबकि 2020 की इसी अवधि में 156.78 मिलियन टन उत्पादन किया गया था। इस तरह सात मिलियन टन अतिरिक्त उत्पादन किया गया है। वहीं, आफ टेक रा कोल की बात की जाए तो इस तिमाही के 31 दिसंबर 2021 तक 173.77 मिलियन टन उत्पादन किया गया, जबकि पिछली तिमाही में 154.46 मिलियन टन उत्पादन हुआ था। इसमें 17 मिलियन टन अतिरिक्त उत्पादन हुआ है। वित्त वर्ष की तीसरी तिमाही में 5990.97 करोड़ का नेट सेल हुआ है।
