ORDER

Sub: Review of orders passed by disciplinary authorities in Vigilance Cases

The Central Vigilance Commission has laid down in the vigilance manual that the Chief Vigilance Offices are required to scrutinize the final orders passed by disciplinary authorities with a view to seeing whether a case for review is made out or not. Accordingly, the orders passed by different disciplinary authorities may be examined and if any case is found fit for review, the matter may be referred to the reviewing authority at the earliest. The following category of cases should invariably be referred to the Reviewing Authority within 7 days of the order :

- i) If at the end of a Disciplinary Proceeding founded on a cause of action out of which a CBI prosecution is also pending and the Disciplinary Authority imposes or proposes any penalty other than dismissal, removal or compulsory retirement.
- ii) The cases in which disciplinary authority has disagreed with the advice of the CVC. This will avoid publication in Annual Report of CVC.

The cases for which Chairman, CIL is the Reviewing Authority may be referred through CVO, CIL.
